

IXPs: the Normative Model

- Neutral facility: anyone may join, uniform membership terms, costs
- Open contracting:
 Membership does not require a commercial or interconnection relationship with anyone in particular
- Reduced cost of operation:

Assuming three or more member networks, joint costs of IXP participation are less than meshed, decentralized bilateral interconnections between the networks

IXP Impacts ala the Normative Model


Direct impacts:

Economic interpretation of the Internet routing table over time, using the Route Views Archive:


